Computer Software Warranty

Seller warrants that computer software delivered under this contract will be free of defects, conform to generally accepted standards of good programming practice, and will comply with all pertinent specifications including performance. All warranties will run to Buyer, its successors, assigns, customers, and users of its products, and they will remain in effect through the period of Seller's warranty obligations under the general contract conditions. If Seller fails to promptly correct deficiencies in any computer software or associated documentation, Buyer may, by contract or otherwise, make the necessary corrections and charge Seller the cost occasioned to Buyer thereby. The remedies provided in this clause are in addition to any other remedies provided to Buyer either at law or in equity and will be cumulative rather than alternative.
