CUSTOMER CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

If Form GP1 is applicable to this procurement, this Attachment constitutes the Customer clauses contemplated by Article 29. If Form GP2 is applicable to this procurement, this Attachment constitutes the Customer clauses contemplated by Article 28. If Form GP3 is applicable to this procurement, this Attachment constitutes the Customer clauses contemplated by Article 41. If Form GP4 is applicable to this procurement, this Attachment constitutes the Customer clauses contemplated by Article 31.

1. The following prime contract special provisions apply to this purchase order:

A. NOTIFICATION OF DEBARMENT/SUSPENSION STATUS

Seller shall provide immediate notice to Buyer in the event of being debarred suspended, or proposed for debarment by any Federal Agency during the performance of this Contract.

B. WARRANTY

The supplier as a specialist is liable to the purchaser both for express representations made and that the goods have no physical or legal defects which eliminate or substantially reduce their fitness for the intended use as defined in the Statement of Work. The warranty period shall be 12 months from the date of acceptance of the goods. Notification of defects will be made by the purchaser in writing within 30 days. The supplier shall even warrant for defects after expiration of the warranty if these defects have occurred during the term of warranty and written notification has been made within 30 days after expiration of the warranty period.

C. DANGEROUS GOODS

For all delivered dangerous goods the purchaser is to be provided with Material Safety Data Sheets which also include the number of the U.N. Classification.

D. RULES OF PROCEDURE

For work performed in Switzerland, supplier shall comply, for his personnel, with the industrial safety provisions and the working conditions at the place of performance. He shall guarantee the equal treatment of women and men with respect to their salary. The working conditions shall be the collective employment contracts or standard employment contracts or, if they do not exist, the actual working conditions acc. to local and professional usage. Supplier shall bind his subcontractors by contract to comply with the above mentioned rules.
