CUSTOMER CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

The following customer contract requirements apply to this contract to the extent indicated below. If this contract is for the procurement of commercial items under a Government prime contract, as defined in FAR Part 2.101, see Section 3 below.

1. Prime Contract Special Provisions The following prime contract special provisions apply to this purchase order

INSURANCE. Seller, as well as its lower-tier subcontractors, shall procure and maintain at least the following kinds of insurance and minimum liability coverage during any period of contract performance:

- a. Worker's compensation and Employers' Liability Insurance in compliance with applicable compensation and occupational disease statues. Employers' liability coverage in the minimum amount of \$100,000.
- b. Comprehensive general liability and bodily injury liability insurance in the minimum limits of \$500,000 per occurrence.
- c. Comprehensive automobile liability insurance policy shall provide bodily injury liability and property damage liability covering the operation of all automobiles used in connection with the performance of the contract in the minimum amounts of \$200,000 per person and \$500,000 per occurrences for bodily injury and \$20,000 per occurrence for property damage.
- d. Seller shall provide thirty (30) days advance written notice prior to the effective date of any cancellation or change in the term or coverage of any of Seller's required insurance. If requested, Seller shall submit to Buyer a Certificate of Insurance showing Seller's compliance with these requirements.
