CUSTOMER CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

The following customer contract requirements apply to this contract to the extent indicated below. If this contract is for the procurement of commercial items under a Government prime contract, as defined in FAR Part 2.101, see Section 3 below.

1. FAR Clauses The following contract clauses are incorporated by reference from the Federal Acquisition Regulation and apply to this contract to the extent indicated. In all of the following clauses, "Contractor" and "Offeror" mean Seller.

52.211-5 Material Requirements (AUG 2000). Any notice will be given to Buyer rather than the Contracting Officer.

52.211-15 Defense Priority and Allocation Requirements (SEP 1990). This clause is applicable if a priority rating is assigned to this contract.

52.222-20 Walsh-Healey Public Contracts Act (DEC 1996). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$10,000.

52.222-26 Equal Opportunity (subparagraphs (b) (1) through (b) (11)) (FEB 1999).

52.222-35 Equal Opportunity for Special Disabled, Veterans of the Vietnam Era, and Other Eligible Veterans (subparagraph (b) (1)) (FEB 1999). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$25,000.

52.222-36 Affirmative Action For Workers With Disabilities (JUN 1998). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$10,000.

52.222-37 Employment Reports on Disabled Veterans and Veterans of the Vietnam Era (JAN 1999). This clause applies only if this contract is for \$10,000 or more.

52.222-41 Service Contract Act of 1965, As Amended (MAY 1989). This clause only applies to contracts which are subject to the Service Contract Act.

52.225-1 Buy American Act-Balance of Payments Program- Supplies (FEB 2000).

52.225-13 Restrictions on Certain Foreign Purchases (JUL 2000).

52.244-6 Subcontracts for Commercial Items and Commercial Components (OCT 1998).

52.247-64 Preference for Privately Owned U.S.-Flag Commercial Vessels (JUN 2000). In paragraph (c)(2) "20" has been changed to 10 and 20 respectively.

2. Commercial Items If goods or services being procured under this contract are commercial items and Clause H203 is set forth in the contract, the foregoing Government clauses in Sections 1 and 2 above are deleted and the following FAR/DFARS clauses are inserted in their place:

52.222-26 Equal Opportunity (subparagraphs (b)(1) through (b)(11)) (FEB 1999).

52.222-35 Affirmative Action for Disabled Veterans and Veterans of the Vietnam Era (APR 1998). This clause applies if this contract exceeds \$10,000.

52.222-36 Affirmative Action For Workers With Disabilities (JUN 1998).

52.247-64 Preference for Privately Owned U.S.-Flag Commercial Vessels (JUN 2000).

3. Prime Contract Special Provisions The following prime contract special provisions apply to this purchase order

Special Provisions Safety Program Requirements .

A. Safety Program Requirements:

1. As a minimum, the contractor shall conform to all applicable Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Standards at their facilities for the protection of DOD property entrusted to the contractor.
2. The contractor will conduct routine and recurring surveillance to ensure the safety requirements of this contract are met. Competent personnel shall be used to perform the surveillance.
3. The contractor shall ensure subcontractors comply with the safety provision of this contract, as applicable.
4. All contractor personnel shall be trained and qualified to perform their job safely.
