CUSTOMER CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

The following customer contract requirements apply to this contract to the extent indicated below. If this contract is for the procurement of commercial items under a Government prime contract, as defined in FAR Part 2.101, see Section 3 below.

1. FAR Clauses The following contract clauses are incorporated by reference from the Federal Acquisition Regulation and apply to the extent indicated. In all of the following clauses, "Contractor" and "Offeror" mean Seller.

52.203-6 Restrictions on Subcontractor Sales to the Government (Sep 2006) Alternate I (OCT 1995). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$100,000.

52.203-13 Contractor Code of Business Ethics and Conduct (APR 2010). This clause applies only if this contract is in excess of \$5,000,000 and has a period of performance of more than 120 days.

52.212-4 Contract Terms and Conditions-Commercial Items (JUN 2010).

52.212-4 Contract Terms and Conditions-Commercial Items Alternate I (OCT 2008).

52.212-5 Contract Terms and Conditions Required to Implement Statutes or Executive Orders - Commercial Items (JUL 2010).

52.212-5 Contract Terms and Conditions Required to Implement Statutes or Executive Orders - Commercial Items Alternate II (JUN 2010).

52.212-5 Contract Terms and Conditions Required to Implement Statutes or Executive Orders - Commercial Items Alternate I (FEB 2000).

52.215-2 Audit and Records - Negotiation (MAR 2009). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$100,000 and (i) is cost-reimbursement, incentive, time-and-materials, labor-hour, or price-redeterminable type or any combination of these types; (ii) Seller was required to provide cost or pricing data, or (iii) Seller is required to furnish reports as discussed in paragraph (e) of the referenced clause.

52.215-21 Requirement for Cost or Pricing Data or Information Other Than Cost and Pricing Data - Modifications (OCT 1997). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds the threshold set forth in FAR 15.403-4. The term "Contracting Officer" shall mean Buyer.

52.215-21 Requirement for Cost or Pricing Data or Information Other Than Cost and Pricing Data - Modifications Alternate I (OCT 1997).

52.215-21 Requirement for Cost or Pricing Data or Information Other Than Cost and Pricing Data - Modifications Alternate II (OCT 1997).

52.215-21 Requirement for Cost or Pricing Data or Information Other Than Cost and Pricing Data - Modifications Alternate III (OCT 1997).

52.215-21 Requirement for Cost or Pricing Data or Information Other Than Cost and Pricing Data - Modifications Alternate IV (OCT 1997).

52.219-8 Utilization of Small Business Concerns (MAY 2004).

52.219-9 Small-Business Subcontracting Plan (APR 2008). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$550,000 and Seller is not a small business concern. Seller shall adopt a subcontracting plan that complies with the requirements of this clause. In addition, Seller shall submit to Buyer Form X31162, Small and Small Disadvantaged Business and Women-Owned Small Business Subcontracting Plan Certificate of Compliance. In accordance with paragraph (d)(10)(iv), Seller agrees that it will submit the ISR and/or SSR using eSRS, and, in accordance with paragraph (d)(10)(vi), Seller agrees to provide the prime contract number, its own DUNS number, and the email address of the Government or Contractor official responsible for acknowledging or rejecting the reports, to its subcontractors with subcontracting plans.

52.219-9 Small Business Subcontracting Plan (DEVIATION) (FEB 2009) Alternate I (OCT 2001). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$550,000 and Seller is not a small business concern. Seller shall adopt a subcontracting plan that complies with the requirements of this clause. In addition, Seller shall submit to Buyer Form X31162, Small and Small Disadvantaged Business and Women-Owned Small Business Subcontracting Plan Certificate of Compliance. In accordance with paragraph (d)(10)(iv), Seller agrees that it will submit the SF 294 and/or SSR using eSRS, in accordance with paragraph (l) of this clause.

52.219-9 Small Business Subcontracting Plan (JUL 2010) Alternate II (OCT 2001). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$550,000 and Seller is not a small business concern. Seller shall adopt a subcontracting plan that complies with the requirements of this clause. In addition, Seller shall submit to Buyer Form X31162, Small and Small Disadvantaged Business and Women-Owned Small Business Subcontracting Plan Certificate of Compliance. In accordance with paragraph (d)(10)(iv), Seller agrees that it will submit the ISR and/or SSR using eSRS, and, in accordance with paragraph (d)(10)(vi), Seller agrees to provide the prime contract number, its own DUNS number, and the email address of the Government or Contractor official responsible for acknowledging or rejecting the reports, to its subcontractors with subcontracting plans. When responding to a solicitation, Seller/Bidder shall comply with the requirements of this clause.

52.222-21 Prohibition of Segregated Facilities (FEB 1999).

52.222-26 Equal Opportunity (MAR 2007).

52.222-26 Equal Opportunity (subparagraph (b)(1) through (11)) Alternate I (FEB 1999).

52.222-35 Equal Opportunity for Special Disabled Veterans, Veterans of the Vietnam Era, and Other Eligible Veterans (SEP 2006). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$100,000.

52.222-35 Equal Opportunity for Special Disabled Veterans, Veterans of the Vietnam Era, and Other Eligible Veterans Alternate I (DEC 2001).

52.222-36 Affirmative Action For Workers With Disabilities (JUN 1998). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$10,000.

52.222-36 Affirmative Action For Workers With Disabilities Alternate I (JUN 1998).

52.222-37 Employment Reports on Special Disabled Veterans, Veterans of the Vietnam Era, and Other Eligible Veterans (SEP

2006). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$100,000.

52.222-39 Notification of Employee Rights Concerning Payment of Union Dues or Fees (DEC 2004).

52.222-41 Service Contract Act of 1965 (NOV 2007). This clause applies only if this contract is subject to the Act.

52.222-50 Combating Trafficking in Persons (FEB 2009). In paragraph (d), the term "Contracting Officer" means Buyer, and in paragraph (e), the term "the Government" means Buyer.

52.222-50 Combating Trafficking in Persons (Feb 2009) Alternate I (AUG 2007). In paragraph (d), the term "Contracting Officer" means Buyer, and in paragraph (e), the term "the Government" means Buyer.

52.222-51 Exemption from Application of the Service Contract Act to Contracts for Maintenance, Calibration, or Repair of Certain Equipment--Requirements (NOV 2007). This clause applies only for exempt services under this contract.

52.222-53 Exemption From Application Of The Service Contract Act To Contracts For Certain Services-Requirements (NOV 2007). This clause applies only to subcontracts for exempt services under this contract.

52.222-54 Employment Eligibility Verification (JAN 2009).

This clause applies to all subcontracts that (1) are for (i) commercial or noncommercial services (except for commercial services that are part of the purchase of a COTS item, or an item that would be a COTS item, but for minor modifications performed by the COTS provider and are normally provided for that COTS item), or (ii) construction; (2) has a value of more than \$3,000; and (3) includes work performed in the United States.

52.225-1 Buy American Act- Supplies (FEB 2009). This clause does not apply if this contract is placed under a Department of Defense contract.

52.225-13 Restriction on Certain Foreign Purchases (JUN 2008).

52.226-6 Promoting Excess Food Donation to Nonprofit Organizations. (MAR 2009). This clause applies only if this contract is in excess of \$25,000 and, under this contract, Seller will perform the provision, service, or sale of food in the United States.

52.245-1 Government Property (Jun 2007) DEVIATION, Alternate I (JUN 2007). This clause applies only if Government property is acquired or furnished for contract performance. Per DEVIATION 2007-O0012, the definition of plant equipment is deleted, and the second sentence in the definition of real property is modified to read: "It does not include foundations and other work necessary for installing personal property." The Government-Owned Property article in GP4 is hereby deleted.

52.247-64 Preference for Privately Owned U.S.-Flag Commercial Vessels (FEB 2006). This clause applies only if this contract is (i) a contract or agreement for ocean transportation services; or a construction contract; or (ii) the supplies being transported are (a) items the Contractor is reselling or distributing to the Government without adding value (generally, the Contractor does not add value to the items when it subcontracts items for f.o.b. destination shipment); or (b) shipped in direct support of U.S. military (1) contingency operations; (2) exercises; or (3) forces deployed in connection with United Nations or North Atlantic Treaty Organization humanitarian or peacekeeping operations.

52.247-64 Preference for Privately Owned U.S.-Flag Commercial Vessels Alternate I (APR 2003). . In paragraph (C)(2) "20" and "30" are changed to 10 and 20 respectively.

2. DoD FAR Supplement Clauses DoD Contracts. The following contract clauses are incorporated by reference from the Department of Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement and apply to the extent indicated. In all of the following clauses, "Contractor" and "Offeror" mean Seller except as otherwise noted.

252.204-7000 Disclosure of Information (DEC 1991). Seller will submit requests for authorization to release through Buyer. Seller shall submit written requests to Buyer a minimum of 60 days prior to proposed date of release.

252.219-7003 Small Business Subcontracting Plan (DOD Contracts) (APR 2007). Except paragraph (g) which is hereby deleted.

252.225-7001 Buy American Act and Balance of Payments Program (JAN 2009).

252.225-7012 Preference for Certain Domestic Commodities (JUN 2010).

252.225-7014 Preference for Domestic Specialty Metals . Applicable clause date is JAN 2008.

252.225-7014 Preference for Domestic Specialty Metals Alternate I Deviation (JAN 2008).

252.225-7016 Restriction on Acquisition of Ball and Roller Bearings (MAR 2006). This clause does not apply to the purchase of commercial items other than ball or roller bearings or to items which contain no ball or roller bearings.

252.225-7016 Alternate I (MAR 2006).

252.225-7038 Restriction on Acquisition of Air Circuit Breakers (JUN 2005).

252.226-7001 Utilization of Indian Organizations and Indian-Owned Economic Enterprises--DoD Contracts and Native Hawaiian Small Business Concerns (SEP 2004). This clause applies only if this contract exceeds \$500,000.

252.227-7015 Technical Data -- Commercial Items (NOV 1995). This clause applies only if the delivery of data is required for commercial items under this contract.

252.227-7037 Validation of Restrictive Markings on Technical Data (SEP 1999). This clause applies only if the delivery of data is required by this contract.

252.237-7019 Training for Contractor Personnel Interacting with Detainees (SEP 2006). (c) *Subcontracts*. The Contractor shall include the substance of this clause, including this paragraph (c), in all subcontracts that may require subcontractor personnel to interact with detainees in the course of their duties.

252.247-7023 Transportation of Supplies by Sea (MAY 2002). This clause applies only if the supplies are of a type described in paragraph (b)(2) of this clause. In paragraph (d), "45 days" is changed to "60 days." In paragraph (g) "Government" means Buyer. If this contract is at or below \$100,000, paragraphs (f) and (g) are excluded.

252.247-7023 TRANSPORTATION OF SUPPLIES BY SEA Alternate III (MAY 2002). This clause applies only if the supplies are of a type described in paragraph (b)(2) of this clause. In paragraph (d), "45 days" is changed to "60 days."

This clause applies if this contract exceeds (i) \$100,000 if included in Buyer's customer RFP or customer contract issued before October 1, 2010 or (ii) \$150,000 if included in Buyer's customer RFP issued on or after October 1, 2010, or if the prime contract was issued prior to October 1, 2010 but was amended after October 1, 2010 to increase the Simplified Acquisition Threshold and (iii) is cost-reimbursement, incentive, time-and-materials, labor-hour or price redeterminable type or any combination of these for which cost or pricing data are required or for which Buyer is required to furnish reports to the Government in accordance with paragraph (e) of this clause.

252.247-7023 Transportation of Supplies by Sea Alternate I (MAR 2000). In paragraph (d), "45 days" is changed to "60 days". In paragraph (g) "Government" means Buyer.

This clause applies if this contract exceeds (i) \$100,000 if included in Buyer's customer RFP or customer contract issued before October 1, 2010 or (ii) \$150,000 if included in Buyer's customer RFP issued on or after October 1, 2010, or if the prime contract was issued prior to October 1, 2010 but was amended after October 1, 2010 to increase the Simplified Acquisition Threshold and (iii) is cost-reimbursement, incentive, time-and-materials, labor-hour or price redeterminable type or any combination of these for which cost or pricing data are required or for which Buyer is required to furnish reports to the Government in accordance with paragraph (e) of this clause.

252.247-7023 Transportation of Supplies by Sea Alternate II (MAR 2000).

252.247-7024 Notification of Transportation of Supplies by Sea (MAR 2000). Contracting Officer and, in the first sentence of paragraph (a), Contractor mean Buyer. This clause applies only if the supplies being transported are noncommercial items or commercial items that (i) Seller is reselling or distributing to the Government without adding value (generally, Seller does not add value to items that it contracts for f.o.b. destination shipment); (ii) are shipped in direct support of U.S. military contingency operations, exercises, or forces deployed in humanitarian or peacekeeping operations; or (iii) are commissary or exchange cargoes transported outside the Defense Transportation System in accordance with 10 U.S.C. 2643.
