Government Source Quality Assurance

Government inspection is required prior to shipment from the Sellers plant. Upon receipt of this purchase order, promptly notify the Government Representative who normally services Seller's plant so that appropriate planning for Government inspection can be accomplished. Request for Government inspection or test shall not require more than 2 workdays of advance notification if the government representative is in residence in the Contractors plant, nor more than 7 workdays in other instances.

On receipt of this purchase order promptly furnish a copy to the Government Representative who normally services the Sellers plant, or if none, furnish a copy to the nearest Army, Navy, Air Force or Defense Supply Agency inspection office. In the event the representative or office cannot be located, Buyer should be notified immediately.

The Seller is responsible for providing the Government Inspector with verifiable evidence that supplies/services meet the requirements of this purchase order.

Each shipment against this purchase order shall include two copies of the Seller's packing sheet bearing evidence that Government Source Inspection was accomplished prior to shipment.

This evidence shall be an impression of the Government Inspector's stamp or signature. If authority is granted to ship in the absence of the Government Inspector, the packing sheet shall include the Government Inspector's name, title/symbol and a reference to the authorizing document.

Government Source Inspection does not constitute final acceptance by either Buyer or Government and does not relieve the Seller of any of the requirements of this purchase order.
