WARRANTY - PURCHASED PARTS

Seller warrants that all goods and services furnished hereunder will conform to the requirements of this contract (including all descriptions, specifications and drawings made a part of this contract), and such goods will be merchantable, fit for their intended purposes, free from all defects in materials and workmanship and to the extent not manufactured pursuant to detailed designs or specifications furnished by Seller shall not relieve Seller of its obligations under this Warranty.

In addition to its other remedies, the Buyer may, at Seller's expense, require prompt correction or replacement of any goods and services failing to meet Seller's warranties herein. Goods and services corrected or replaced by Seller shall be subject to all of the provisions of this contract and to the extent as goods and services originally furnished hereunder.

If Seller receives a request from the Buyer or the U.S. Government to perform a routine correction, repair, or maintenance of a product, Seller shall perform any required work within a period of ten (10) working days or less from the receipt of product and authority to proceed.

All warranties, including special warranties specified elsewhere herein, shall run to the Buyer, its successors, assigns, customers and users of its products. The warranties shall be applicable for twelve months after delivery of the goods to the Buyer's customer.

This Warranty is in lieu of and replaces the Article entitled "Warranty", as set forth in the General Terms and Conditions/General Provisions.
