Test records shall be maintained by Seller, and made available to Buyer upon request. The data will verify that all specified test requirements have been performed and shall include, but not be limited to, test parameters and related limits; test set-up; test methods; and test results.

Deviations from specification requirements are not authorized unless documented in writing by Seller and approved by Buyer prior to shipment of product hereunder.

The Certification of Conformance shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- 1. Buyer's Purchase Order Number.
- 2. Buyer's specification number and revision level.
- 3. Manufacturer's part number (if different than Buyer's specification number).
- 4. Applicable date codes or lot identification numbers.
