GOVERNMENT PROVISIONS

APPLICABLE TO

PRIME CONTRACT F34601-96-C-0041

The clauses contained in the following Government regulations are incorporated by reference. Where necessary or appropriate to derive proper meaning in a subcontract situation, "Contractor" shall mean Seller. Government Clauses listed below or cited elsewhere in the contract shall be those in effect in May 1995 except FAR 52.244-6 which is October 1995.

52.223-2	Clean Air and Water (Also applicable if Seller's facility has been the subject of a conviction under the Clean Air Act or Federal Water Pollution Control Act.)
252.203-7001	Special Prohibition on Employment
252.247-7023	Transportation of Supplies by Sea
252.249-7002	Notification of Proposed Program Termination or Reduction
