



Section 1 : SOLICITATION CLAUSES

108. Royalties (10/1/96). If Bidder's proposal contains costs or charges for royalties, license fees, patent or license amortization costs, or similar costs or fees totaling more than \$250.00, include the following information with the proposal for each item of royalty, license fee, or cost:

- (a) Name and address of the licensor;
- (b) Date of the license agreement;
- (c) The patent numbers, patent application serial numbers, or other basis upon which the royalty is payable;
- (d) A brief description, including any part or model numbers, of each offered item or component with respect to which the royalty is payable;
- (e) The percentage or dollar rate of the royalty per unit;
- (f) The unit price;
- (g) The number of units; and
- (h) The total dollar amount of royalties.

In addition, as a precondition to the execution of the contract contemplated by this solicitation, Buyer may require a copy of the current license agreement and identification of the applicable claims of specific patents.
