



Section 3 : ADMINISTRATIVE CLAUSES

301. Dangerous Goods and Hazardous Materials (10/1/96).

(a) Packaging, packing, marking, labeling, shipping paper designations and certifications, handling, and movement of materials ordered herein will be in accordance with all relevant and applicable U.S. laws and regulations, including 49 CFR Parts 100-199, and all international regulations (i.e., ICAO or IMDG) covering shipments of dangerous goods or hazardous materials. In addition, all inner containers of combination packaging and single packages will conform to the hydrostatic pressure test requirements of 49 CFR 173.27(c) and 178.605. Seller will provide required test data on all tested packages.

(b) Materials potentially injurious to the user will have unit containers marked or labeled with applicable instructions in accordance with CAL-OSHA General Industry Safety Order, Title 8, Article 112, Labeling of Injurious Substances.

(c) For materials procured in drums, Seller will identify fire and health precautions on opposite sides and tops of drums.
