

Section 3 : ADMINISTRATIVE CLAUSES

370. Compressed Gas (Pressure Vessels) and Cryogenic Liquids (10/1/96). Prior to shipment of goods purchased hereunder, Seller will ensure that all vessels containing material meeting the definition of compressed gas or cryogenic liquid as given in 49 CFR Part 173 is identified with appropriate Department of Transportation specification number, unless exempted by 49 CFR 173.306 for compressed gases or 49 CFR 173.320 for cryogenic liquids. If so exempted, Seller will provide Buyer with three copies of written certification giving the nature and authority for exemption, citing the specific paragraph in 49 CFR. Unless compressed gases or cryogenic liquids are supplied in DOT specification cylinders or exempted as described above, Seller will obtain and submit to Buyer a DOT exemption issued under authority of 49 CFR Part 107, or for DoD contracts, a certificate of equivalency (COE) issued under authority established in NAV MAT INSTRUCTION 4030.11. In each case, Seller will submit three copies of DOT exemption or COE, as applicable, to Buyer before shipment.

Definitions:

"Compressed gas" is any material or mixture having in the container an absolute pressure exceeding 40 psi at 70deg.F or 104 psi at 130deg.F.

"Cryogenic liquid" is a refrigerated, liquefied gas having a boiling point colder than -130deg.F (-90deg.C) at one atmosphere, absolute.

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
