

## Section 6: QUALITY ASSURANCE CLAUSES / CQAR

606. Buyer's Quality Source Surveillance Validation of Seller's First Article Inspection Report (10/1/96).

- (a) Upon receipt of this contract, Seller will promptly notify Buyer's Quality Source Surveillance Representative (QSSR) who normally services its plant so that appropriate planning for Buyer's surveillance of the First Article Inspection (FAI) can be accomplished. Seller can contact Buyer's authorized purchasing representative for direction to Buyer's nearest Quality Assurance office.
- (b) First Article Inspection (FAI) or test will be performed by Seller at Seller's facility in accordance with Buyer's Corporate Quality Assurance Regulation (CQAR) 16, First Article Inspection Requirements for McDonnell Douglas Corporation Suppliers. Quantitative results will be documented in a report identified as the "First Article Inspection Report." Seller will notify Buyer's QSSR at least 48 hours in advance to schedule Buyer's surveillance of the FAI. Buyer's QSSR will verify conformity of Seller's FAI, as applicable, and will document results in the FAI Report. One copy of the FAI Report will be retained by Seller as evidence of Buyer's approval of the FAI, and one copy will be forwarded with Seller's shipper to Buyer.
